



OPSB to consider Geauga power line case at Nov. 24 meeting

Our case is now on the agenda for the next meeting of the Ohio Power Siting Board in Columbus, OH on Monday, November 24, at 3:30 p.m.

We all knew that it was coming. Case 07-171-EL-BTX, The Geauga County 138 kV Transmission Supply Project is now on the agenda to be considered at the November meeting of the Ohio Power Siting Board.

The meeting will be held at PUCO Headquarters, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, Hearing Room E, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793. The meeting is open to the public and everyone interested in attending is encouraged to do so.

What will be the outcome of this meeting?

OPSB could grant a certificate for construction of the Clay Street Route per the application, or

OPSB could grant a certificate for construction of the 528 Route per the application, or

OPSB could grant a certificate for construction of one of the routes with modifications and conditions, or

OPSB could deny the application and not grant any certificate, or

OPSB could decide to postpone considering our case and do nothing until next year, or

OPSB could do something completely different that no one has considered.

Citizens Advocating Responsible Energy (CARE) will attend this meeting and will have legal counsel present. Legal counsel will be critical in case FirstEnergy attempts to twist the process in their favor, or if the Administrative Law Judge makes a procedural error that warrants an objection.
